Plastic Primer

Adhesion primer for plastics ensures good adhesion of the following coats (filler, topcoat).

Non-modified polypropylene (PP) and polyethylene (PE) are unpaintable.

Note: Automotive add-on parts are often just labelled PP or PE although they are, in fact, modified and thus paintable substrates.

Shake vigorously for 2 min. before use.

Flash off at 20°C

15 min ,before applying baslac 20-24/34/94 filler. Apply baslac 21-20 again when the flash-off time exceeds 30 min. at 20°C.

Application Remark

when applying 2 spray coats, 5 min. intermediate flash-off between the coats
